

The EIC will focus on supporting disruptive/breakthrough innovations too risky for private investors, with either 'Pathfinder' grants (for early tech) or 'Accelerator' funding (for pre-commercial work).






The EIE will focus on developing networks of interactions between innovators.

The EIT will be complementary to the EIC by bringing key research, education, and business actors together around a common goal.



The EIC is **Europe's most ambitious innovation initiative, with over €10 billion** to invest in breakthrough technologies and game changing innovations.

- Unique in the world, combining a "DARPA" approach for advanced technological research with an accelerator to scale up innovative startups and SMEs
- New **EIC Fund is the largest early-stage, deep-tech investor in Europe** (over €3 billion) aiming to crowd in other investors
- Open to support innovators in **any field, at any time, from anywhere in Europe**. Particular focus on **deep tech and disruptive innovations**, and attracting more **female innovators** and talent from **less innovative regions**.
- Acts as an impact fund for the rest of Horizon Europe, pulling through research results into innovations
- Enhances the European innovation ecosystem, through partnerships with the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT), the European Research Council, and national/regional agencies and ecosystem builders



EIC Accelerator financing for startups and SMEs from early stage (seed, first rounds) to growth

• Substantial, founder-friendly, financial support (**up to €17.5 million in non-** European **dilutive grants, patient investment capital**, flexibility to pivot) Innovation Council



- Free mentoring, coaching, and access to leading corporates, investors, and innovation partners.
- Applications start with a short simple pitch, submitted at any time.
 Funding decisions are fast (2-3 months from full application)
- Highly competitive, with 200-300 startups and SMEs selected each year with the most high-risk/high impact innovations and the potential to be global leaders



If the activity concerns a primarily technological innovation, a **Technology Readiness Level (TRL) of 5/6** or above is envisaged.

The EIC Accelerator focuses in particular on innovations building on scientific discovery or technological breakthroughs and through the funding it will support innovators to attract the full investment amounts needed for scale up in a shorter timeframe. You can subcontract work essential for your innovation project. Subsidy:

Grant: max. €2.5M

• Blended finance: grant of max. €2.5M + max. €15M equity

Deadline: 3 stage application process

Short proposal: apply anytime

Full proposal: 16 June and 6 October 2021

Interview rounds: TBD
